







M FRENCH NATIONAL CLASS ASSOCIATION French Radiosailing Marblehead Class Championship 2015

Selection procedures

The French Radiosailing Marblehead Class Championship (FRMCC) will take place from 14 to 17 May 2015 at the Étang du Vignoble (Valenciennes). It will be in collaboration with the Cercle de voile de Valenciennes (CVV).

This document describes the running of the event and the selection procedure.

Running of the event:

- The FRMCC will be governed by the Heat Management System 2013.
- The number of entries will be limited to 62 (i.e. 4 heats of 20 boats with 6 boat promotion.

Selection will proceed as follows:

For FFVoile Affiliated competitors on the FFVoile national ranking list (CNC) on 25 November 2014:

- Must be up to date to their 2015 NCA membership.
- Online registration recommended. Payment of the entry fees and of additional meals (as per NoR) shall be returned to the CVV post marked 14 April 2015 midnight.
- The applicants amongst the first 52 on the ranking list, who have returned a complete entry package, will be selected.

For Competitors from another ISAF National Authority:

- Must up to date to their 2015 Marblehead NCA membership.
- Online registration recommended. Payment of the entry fees and of the meals (as per NoR) shall be returned to the CVV post marked 14 March 2015 midnight.
- 10 places are initially allocated for competitors from another ISAF national authority.
- The applicants amongst the first 10 on the final ranking list of the last Marblehead Class World Championship (Gouda 2014) who have returned a complete entry package will be selected. Should any slots remain within the limit of 10 entries, competitors will be selected in order of receipt by the CVV of their complete entry package.

At the closing date for application for competitors from another ISAF National Authority, the number of additional slots available for FFVoile affiliated competitors will be posted on the event website on 15 March 2015.

The list of selected competitors and the reserve list, as appropriate, will be posted on the event website on 15 April 2015.

Should any slots remain within the limit of 62 entries, FFVoile affiliated competitors on the CNC on 14 April 2015 may be accepted pending approval of the French NCA and the CVV.

Then, if any slots remain within the limit of 62 entries on 22 April 2015, competitors from another ISAF national authority may be accepted.
